
Did You Miss It? Well, lucky for you we have it.

Physician Donations to be Matched for 2nd CT Scanner

A Message from Drs Weatherman, Hardy, and Cunningham

A lot of work has gone on behind the scenes and over \$5.0 Million has been raised. We're almost at the finish line with only \$900,000 left to go to achieve our goal. As we approach year end, and some of us are thinking of our taxes, consider the **Galbraith Family matching challenge for physicians** to inspire and lead others to donate.

As a reminder, there is also the benefit of the personal tax credit benefits as well as the impacts to our patients.

Tax benefits. Combined federal and provincial tax credits are at 43.7% (with donations over \$200). That means that a donation of \$1,000 can costs you only \$562, but your impact is \$2,000 towards our goal. There's also significant tax advantages of donating shares. Consider **Canada Revenue Agency Tax Credit Calculator** and talking to your financial advisors.

Patient impact: One scanner dedicated to emergency, trauma and in-hospital use. The other for community and interventional procedures. Rapid access. Timeline diagnoses. Better outcomes. Sooner.
